

A Pilgrimage for the opening of TPOTS Church Buildings for Public Worship - 5th July 2020

You are all welcome for all or any part of the day walking, riding, or driving.

All times approximate.

0845h	Leave The Rectory, East Brent, turn left on Brent Road and then up the drive by Holly House (to the West of Red House Road) and across the fields.
0910h	Arrive on Wrentmoor Lane/South Road
0920h	Arrive South Road/Church Road junction.
0925h	Arrive at St Christopher's gate
0930h	1 Peter 2:1-10 and acclamations as we enter the building – below. <i>(Please at all times observe strict social distancing of at least 2m and enter the building as directed, using marked pews only from the front. Morning Prayer (Common Worship) – see notes below</i>
0950h	You will be directed how to leave the church. Depart for home. The church will then be locked.
Rest	
1145h	Leave The Rectory via Brent Road and Church Road to St Mary's
1155h	Arrive at St Mary's gate.
Noon	Psalm 127 and acclamations as we enter the building – below. <i>(Please at all times observe strict social distancing of at least 2m and enter the building as directed, using marked pews only from the front. Prayers during the Day (Common Worship) – see notes below</i>
1120h	You will be directed how to leave the church. Depart for home. The church will then be locked.

1445h	Depart The Rectory walk up Hill Lane
1510h	On the way down arrive at the path to the Knoll by the car park/farm. Cut across the fields to the path behind the church.
1525h	Arrive at St Michael's steps.
1530h	Ephesians 2:19-22 and acclamations as we enter the building – below. <i>(Please at all times observe strict social distancing of at least 2m and enter the building as directed, using marked pews only from the front. Evening Prayer (Common Worship) – see notes below</i>
1550h	You will be directed how to leave the church. Depart for home. The church will then be locked.
